This chart displays the Fund's performance as the percentage loss or gain per year over a period of up to 10 years, relative to its benchmark.

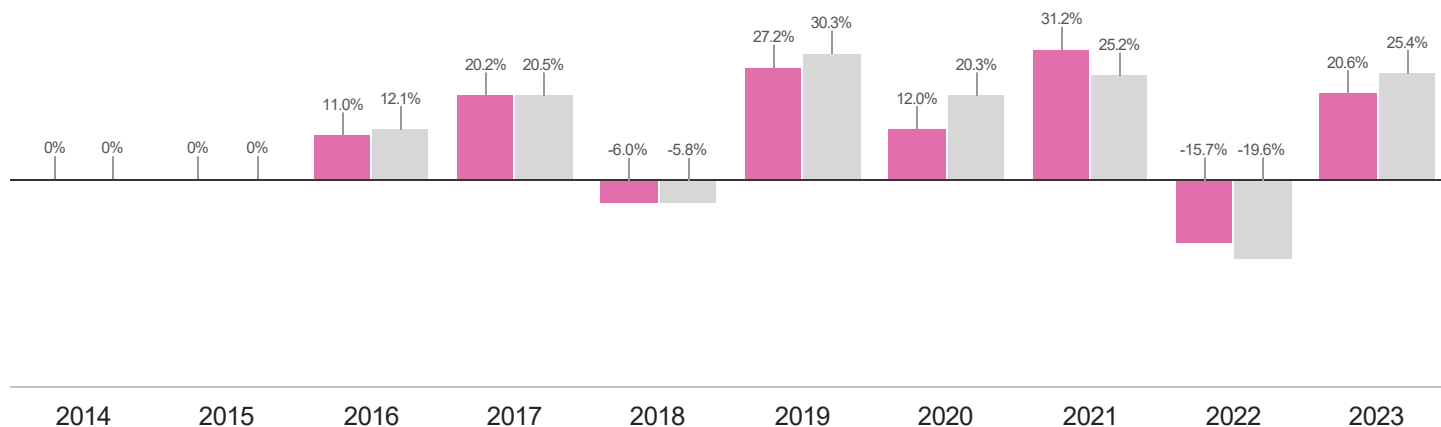
